

**CHARGES FOR AERODROMES/HELIPORTS
AND AIR NAVIGATION SERVICES**

1.AERODROME/HELIPORT CHARGES

<p align="center">1.Landing of aircraft</p> <p>1.1 Charges are based on the maximum permissible take-off Weight of the aircraft ,as specified in the C.of A.</p> <p>1.2 Daytime landing (Day: period of time between 30 minutes before sunrise and 30 minutes after sunset).</p> <p>1.2.1 All aircraft : 6 000 Lebanese pounds per 1 000 KG or fraction thereof.</p> <p>1.2.2 When more than two landings .are made at the same aerodrome during the same day, the total landing charge will be double the amount. of the single landing charge for the aircraft.</p> <p>1.3 Night time landings (Night: period of time between 30 minutes after sunset and 30 minutes before sunrise).</p> <p>1.3.1 Supplementary charge of 250 000 Lebanese pounds for each landing, take-off or movement on the aerodrome, during which lighting is used.</p> <p>1.3.2 A supplementary charge of 8 000 Lebanese pounds for each period of 5 minutes or fraction thereof during which lighting is used, as mentioned in paragraph 1.3.1.</p> <p align="center">2. Parking, hangarage and long-term storage of aircraft</p> <p>2.1 Parking of aircraft</p> <p>2.1.1 3500 Lebanese pounds per 1 000 KG or fraction thereof for the first 75 000 KG.</p> <p>2.1.2 2500 Lebanese pounds per 1 000 KG or fraction thereof above 75 000 KG.</p> <p>2.1.3 These rates are per 24 hours or fraction thereof on condition that the fraction exceeds eight hours.</p>	<p>2.2 Hangarage charges</p> <p>2.2.1 5000 Lebanese pounds per 1 000 KG or fraction thereof for the first 75 000 KG.</p> <p>2.2.2 3500 Lebanese pounds per 1 000 KG or fraction thereof above 75 000 KG.</p> <p>2.2.3 These rates are per 24 hours or fraction thereof.</p> <p>2.3 Boarding bridges charges</p> <p>150 000 Lebanese pounds for each period of three hours or fraction thereof.</p> <p align="center">3.passenger service</p> <p>3.1 Each passenger departing Beirut International Airport is charged , if bound for any other country:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) 50 000 Lebanese pounds for economy class, b) 70 000 Lebanese pounds for business class, c) 100 000 Lebanese pounds for first class, <p>3.2 The above charges mentioned in para 3.1 are reduced to half for passengers departing to Cyprus and Syria</p> <p>3.3 The aircraft operator or his designated agent is responsible for collecting the above charges.</p> <p align="center">4. Exemptions and reductions</p> <p>7.1 Exemptions</p> <p>7.1.1 The following aircraft categories are exempted from landing charges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State aircraft (A/C. • Head of states A/C. • Diplomatic and consular A/C. • International Red Cross A/C. • UN organization and its agencies. • A/C making test flight without carrying passengers. • A/C of officially approved flying schools. • A/C in Search and Rescue (SAR) • A/C exclusively carrying humanitarian aids or grants for Lebanese Government. <p>7.2.2 The following passengers are exempted from Airport Charges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Personalities visiting Lebanon by official invitation . • Chief diplomatic delegation, consulars, secretaries belonging to diplomatic corps appointed in Lebanon, with their families, if holding political passports. • Technical and military attaché appointed in Lebanon • General consuls , consuls and deputy consuls appointed in Lebanon. • United Nations organizations staff in Lebanon and their families holding UN passports. • Persons delegated by the Lebanese Government for Official Mission possessing a travel order or any other document proving this mission. • Children under TWO years of age. Transit passengers staying not more than 24 hours in Lebanon. • Aircraft crew members. 	<p>7.1 Reductions</p> <p>NIL</p> <p>7.2 Cargo</p> <p>NIL</p> <p>8. 2AIR NAVIGATION FACILITY CHARGES

Air navigation charges shall be collected from A/C overflying Lebanese Airspace and not landing at Lebanese Airports, in accordance with the maximum take-off weight (MTOW) as Indicated in the C OF A.

4.2.1 A/C MTOW 70 tons or less: 75 000 (LP).

4.2.2 A/C exceeding 70 tons: 150 000 (LP).
